CSBG funds innovative programs That are administered by 60 different community-based organizations statewide, with the intent to alleviate the causes and conditions of poverty that residents of California face. The services provided by CSBG agencies varies by area but can include everything from food assistance to housing assistance, employment training, education services, emergency services, and more. Contact the CSBG in your area to learn what services are available!

CSBG services are designed to assist low-income families attain the skills, knowledge, and motivation necessary to achieve economic security. Program eligibility is bawd on federal income guidelines and assistance may be provided to eligible low-income families and individuals that qualify.
