Q. What is the proper respect to be shown during the playing of the National Anthem?

A. During the rendition of the National Anthem when the Flag is displayed, all present including those in uniform should stand at attention, facing the Flag with the right hand over the heart. Men not in uniform should remove their headdress with the right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, the hand being over the heart. Persons in uniform should render the military salute at the first note of the Anthem and retain this position until the last note. When the Flag is not displayed, those present should face toward the music and act in the same manner they would if the Flag were displayed there.
